# CLUB SERVICES

## Locker Room

Locker room services are available to members and guests. All attire changes should be made in the locker rooms. An attendant is on duty and will accommodate requests. Shoes with “soft spikes” as approved by East Lake Golf Club are required for play. East Lake Golf Club may not be held liable in the event personal property is lost or stolen. Please use lockers provided.

## Valet Parking

Complimentary valet parking is available to all members and guests.

## Club Storage

Club storage is available to members. Please make arrangements with the Head Golf Professional.

## Club Rental

Right and left-handed clubs are available. Please contact the Golf Shop to reserve.

## Club Repair

Club repair is available to members. Please contact the Golf Shop for information.

## Lessons

Lessons are available by appointment. Please contact the Head Golf Professional for information regarding scheduling and rates.

## Golf Clinics and Programs

Clinics and programs are available upon request. Please contact the Head Golf Professional for information.

## Golf Handicap

Members may establish a U.S.G.A. handicap. A minimum of five current scores is needed for set-up. Participation in most club events requires a current handicap.

# MONTHLY STATEMENTS & FIXED CHARGES

## Monthly Statements

A detailed statement of charges will be mailed to the member’s designated mailing address within five business days of the close of each month.

## Dues

Dues are billed on the first day of the month and will be reflected on the monthly statement.

## Quarterly Club Service Fee

Service fees are billed on the March, June, September, and December member statements. This fee represents payment of gratuities for the membership and its guests and also includes service fees typically associated with locker room, bag storage, golf handicap tracking, practice range, and valet parking.

# FEES AND CHARGES

## Guest Fees

Guest fees will be billed to the sponsoring member on the day of play.

Accompanied Guest	\$ 130.00
Unaccompanied Guest	\$ 190.00

## Caddie Fees

Caddie fee rates are based on the skill level of the caddie and are billed on a per BAG carried basis.

Honor Caddie – 18 holes	\$ 70.50
Honor Caddie – 9 holes	\$ 42.50
A Caddie – 18 holes	\$ 60.50
A Caddie – 9 holes	\$ 32.50
B Caddie – 18 holes	\$ 50.50
B Caddie – 9 holes	\$ 27.50

In the event of inclement weather, caddie fees will be charged as follows:

Once a group commences play, the 9-hole rate applies; once a group commences play on their second nine, the 18-Hole rate applies.

## Rain-out Fees

In the event of inclement weather and the course is closed, a reduced fee will be charged based on the number of holes completed.

Through Hole #4 or less:	No Charge
Hole #5 – Hole #12:	\$100.00 unaccompanied \$75.00 accompanied
After Hole #12 :	Full Fees apply

### Cancellation Fees

If a reserved tee time is not cancelled by 5:00 p.m. the day prior to play, a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee will be charged to the member's account. During peak play periods, the full value of the tee time may be charged.

The cancellation fee will be used to compensate the caddies who were scheduled to work.

For Tuesday tee times, cancellations may be made online or by leaving a voice mail message at 404-687-8955 by 12:00 NOON the Monday prior to play.

Additionally, during peak demand periods, if a tee time is not cancelled as stated above the full value of the tee time (Guest Fees and Caddie Fees) may be charged to the member's account. For Masters Week, a 72 hour advance cancellation notice is required to avoid a full charge.

In the event of inclement weather, cancellation fees may be adjusted to reflect that day's circumstances on a case-by-case basis. For these weather-induced cancellations, the fee will be \$10 per player.

### Golf Shop Merchandise

Golf Shop Merchandise is available to members and guests and may be purchased via cash or credit card. (American Express, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover.)

### Food and Beverage

Food and beverage service is available in the Grill Room and the Halfway House. The Beverage Cart is available during peak seasons.

A 20% service charge will be added to each food and beverage check.

## POLICIES

### Tee Times

Reserved tee times are required and may be obtained by calling the Golf Shop or by booking online at [www.eastlakegolfclub.com](http://www.eastlakegolfclub.com). The names of the players must be submitted to the Golf Shop by 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to play. Play is limited to groups of four players or less.

### Guests

Guests will be granted access to the Club only with prior notification. Guest names must be available to Front Gate Staff prior to arrival.

### Player Registration and Check-out

The member or a representative from each group must check-in at the Golf Shop before beginning play.

### Tipping

East Lake is a "NO-TIPPING" Club. It is imperative that all guests are informed of this policy in advance.

## Attire

Golf attire is permissible in all areas of the Clubhouse except at evening events where participants have been advised that the wearing of jackets, or appropriate dinner attire for women, is required.

Shorts are permitted but styling must be in line with what is commonly referred to as “golf attire”. Please, no cargo shorts. All golfers are requested to remove hats inside the Clubhouse and have the hat bills facing forward when worn outside. Shirts should remain tucked in at all times.

Upon completion of play, members and guests are permitted to change from golf attire into country club casual attire, which includes denim. Country Club appropriate denim is defined as properly sized, in excellent condition, and consistent in color. Country Club appropriate denim does not include holes or rips, frayed material, denim shorts, work type denim shirts, bibs, painter pants, or jeans that are worn extremely low cut. Tasteful and appropriate shirts and shoes must be worn. Shirts should be tucked in unless tailored for outside wear.

Members are encouraged to consider common sense, respect for tradition, modesty, and the comfort of fellow members and their guests when making casual-attire decisions. We prefer our members dress-up rather than dress-down when visiting the Club. While we expect that members will use good taste and judgment, Club Management will discreetly review any inappropriate casual attire decisions directly with the member to ensure that the Club maintains a casual environment that is enjoyable for everyone.

## Practice Areas

Practice areas are available to members and registered guests. We invite members to enjoy our two putting greens, chipping green, short range and full length practice areas. Some areas may be closed at times due to extreme weather conditions. Please contact the Golf Shop to determine the daily availability.

## First Tee

All golfers must begin on hole #1 unless otherwise approved by the starter or other golf staff.

## Caddies

East Lake is a walking only golf club and caddies are required. There is a 25-pound weight limit on golf bags. Should a golf bag exceed this limit, a lighter weight bag may be substituted at no charge. However, after 4:00 p.m. EST or 5:00 p.m. DST, a member may play and carry his bag. Guests are not permitted to play without a caddie.

## Caddie Evaluations

To better evaluate caddie performance, members and guests are asked to complete an evaluation after each round. Evaluation cards are available in the Golf Shop.

## Golf Bags

There is a 25-pound weight limit on golf bags. Should a golf bag exceeds this limit, a lighter weight bag may be substituted at no charge.

### Golf Carts

Golf Carts are available only to those players who have a State Issued Handicap Certificate. Only the individual possessing the handicap certificate will be permitted to use the golf cart. Wet conditions on the course may limit the days on which golf carts are allowed. A caddie will accompany each golf cart and carry the golf bags.

### Pace of Play

The pace of play for groups of 4 at East Lake is 4 ½ hours (15 minutes per hole) for 18 holes. Groups who are unable to maintain this pace should allow faster players to play through.

### Course Evacuation/Inclement Weather

Golfers are warned that lightning has been the cause of many deaths and injuries on golf courses. If lightning is in the area, all play should cease and players should seek immediate cover. The Clubhouse is centrally located on the property and shelters are available on both sides of the golf course. A golf course evacuation map is posted and available in the Golf Shop.

While Club Management may, from time to time, attempt to warn players of lightning or other hazards, Club Management does not warrant or guarantee its ability to detect all instances of lightning or other hazards. Golfers are responsible for their own safety at all times.

Club Management shall not be held liable for failing to warn players of hazardous weather conditions or the need to cease play and seek safe shelter.

### Cell Phone / Smart Phone Use

(Clubhouse & Golf Course)

Members and guests may receive and send text messages and emails and may surf the web on cell phones, smart phones, or other handheld devices provided that no voice communication takes place and that the device's speaker and/or ringing mechanism is silenced. Members are reminded that they should play without delay and the use of such devices should be as limited as possible. Club management will address any abuse of this policy on a case by case basis.

Voice communication via cell phone is limited to the phone closets located in the locker rooms and on the first floor near the entrance to The Grill Room. Members and guests may also use a cell phone for voice communication in any private room, provided that the use is not disruptive to other members and guests.

The Clubhouse is Wi-Fi equipped. The use of laptop computers is allowed in all meeting rooms, the locker rooms and in The Grill Room.

### Smoking:

Smoking is not allowed inside the Clubhouse.
